A couple of weeks ago we showed a short video from the Archbishop about the Catholic Services Appeal. You may not have gotten the nuance that in recent years it was a collection for the Catholic Services Appeal Foundation, separate from the Archdiocese. In January it returned to the responsibility

foundation. The mission is the same, but the change has allowed for some improvements such as a cleaner mailing list, savings on administration, and a focus on the efforts of the Archbishop. As before, the money collected for this appeal goes to serve the needs of many interests of the Catholic Church, including Catholic Education, outreach to college students, seminary training, life issues, support for marriages and family life, and chaplains for large hospitals. There are many other organizations and causes that are supported, things our parish uses along with the Archdiocese, and things we could not fund on our own. Please support this appeal. *Thank you*!

The Saint Joseph Festival will be on Friday, March 15 this year. In addition to the Fish Fry, there will be beer sales, bingo, a low-cost Kid's Carnival area, and a raffle. Raffle tickets will be in the mail by the time you read this – the top prize is \$2,500, with a second prize of \$1,000, two prizes of \$500, and two of \$250. Bingo starts at 5:30 pm in the gym, with Grand Bingo at 7:30 pm. Doors open for the fish fry at 4:30 pm.

Last weekend, our OCIA candidates celebrated the Rite of Election. Those who have not been baptized yet are now Catechumens, a major step toward being baptized. They will be in some intense preparation in the coming four weeks, culminating with the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil on March 30. them. During the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent, they will be celebrating the Scrutinies at the 5:15 pm, 8:30 am, and 10:30 am Masses, respectively. These are times for them to examine themselves closely about their readiness for these Sacraments while we pray for them.

I have picked up a roommate! Deacon Hjalmar Gudjonsson will be staying at the rectory several nights most weeks until he is ordained a priest late in May. He teaches at Holy Family Catholic High School in Victoria and is also assigned to Divine Mercy Church in Faribault. He has a fascinating personal history: he was born in Iceland (and his parents are Icelandic), spent some time in Sweden growing up, was an Augustinian Friar in Austria for seven years, discerned out of that life, and now is a candidate for the priesthood here in our Archdiocese. He speaks several languages. His formation and academic background are so deep he does not attend seminary this semester. He found he didn't have enough to do during the week as a deacon, so he asked for more and is filling a spot at Holy Family teaching theology. Given the distance to Faribault, he stays here some nights and/or when there are winter travel issues or events into the day. If you see him around, welcome him!

The school is undergoing a self-audit of sorts under the name ATO, Accelerating the Organization. The strategy will be to identify areas where expenses are high and develop a plan to reduce expenses and transfer the savings to scholarships and teacher salaries. We hope to increase efficiency by eliminating duplicate work, identifying things that are no longer needed, and redirecting that effort and expense in more useful directions. The plan includes sharing the results with staff and getting their input and ideas.

WHY DO WE REMAIN STANDING AFTER THE GOSPEL IS READ?

Here at St. Joseph, we remain standing until after the Gospel book, in which are found the words of Christ himself, is enthroned. Simply put, Jesus should be the first to sit down.
