Happy St. Patrick's Day! Of course during Lent, Sunday always takes precedence; I am sure many of you will be celebrating this great saint this weekend in a variety of ways. Blessings on all of you with Irish blood in your veins. St. Patrick himself, of course, was born in Britain of a Romanized family. Most know that he was kidnapped during an Irish raid and spent six years in slavery as a herdsman in Ireland before escaping and eventually being

reunited with his family. Later, he felt a calling to return to Ireland and spread the Christian faith there. He was an enormously successful evangelizer, and during his lifetime almost all of Ireland was converted to Christianity.

On Tuesday this week, we celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph. The Mass with the school will take place on that day this week rather than on Wednesday. Deacon Bruce, our principal, will be preaching that day. Please come to celebrate our Patronal Feast Day! Due to a scheduling challenge, we will also have Mass at Auburn Meadows on the 19 at 11:00 am rather than the usual 3rd Wednesday at 1:30 pm. Although St. Joseph speaks no words in the gospels, he is an enormously beloved saint and patron of carpenters, workers, and fathers. He is also patron of many different countries representing four different continents. March 19 is also the anniversary of the installation of Francis as pope in 2013. (He was elected on March 13 that year.)

We are in the final two weeks of Lent! Starting this past week all the daily readings are from the gospel according to John (except for major feasts like St. Joseph). The first readings are, as they have been all Lent, from the Old Testament. This week, we also begin using a Passion Preface (the part just before the Holy, Holy, Holy) rather than a regular Lent one. Next Sunday is Palm/Passion Sunday. We begin those Masses with a reading of the Palm Sunday gospel, bless the palm branches, and have a simple procession into the church. The gospel during Mass that day is the entire Passion; this year it is according to Matthew. Palm Sunday is also the start of Holy Week, which I will write more about next week. March 25, would normally be the Feast of the Annunciation, but with Easter is so early this year, that date falls during Holy Week. In those cases, we move the Feast of the Annunciation past Easter and Easter week, and won't be celebrating it until April 8 this year.

All of our small groups have started now, with the last one beginning March 11. We are having a quick meeting this Sunday to see how things are going, and in April will gather a larger group to review and then start planning groups for the Fall and beyond. We will have a greater variety of topics.


