




Know, Love, and Serve the Lord





Happy Easter! Lent is behind us, we are in the Triduum, the three most sacred days of the year (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday/Easter), and we proclaim that Jesus is risen! Now we have the 50-day Easter Season, culminating in Pentecost. Easter is the Good News. Easter brought incredible joy to the disciples as they saw, spoke with,

and ate with the risen Jesus who had been crucified, who died, and who was buried. The angel tells the women, "You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him. But go and tell his disciples and Peter 'He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him, as he told you." (Easter Vigil Gospel). We are in a world right now with a great deal of bad news, injustice, division, and sometimes weirdness. It is a big election year and weary people need hope. We need to go to whatever our Galilee is. Let the joy of Easter clothe you, comfort you, excite you, and help you to see beyond what we think to be.

Congratulations to all our OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults). At the Easter Vigil, six were baptized along with seven others who also received various combinations of being received into the Church, confirmed, and receiving First Holy Communion. Some of these thirteen have been meeting with team members since June. There may be several others who will complete their initiation to the Church in the coming months. Next year we hope to have another large group. Talk to your friends and family members who either were never confirmed or never baptized and have them take a look at this journey to know about Christ and the Church.

To all those who are here for the first time, or the first time in a while, please come back. We are always better together than apart. In addition to the beautiful church building, we are living stones who seek to know, love, and serve the Lord. We have faith formation possibilities for all ages and groups. We have a school second to none. We have a growing community that I hope takes the best of all ages in our Catholic tradition. So, come back, and let's make something great together.
