


Happy Memorial Day! As many of you know, Memorial began as "Decoration Day," a day to beautify the graves of Civil War Soldiers. After WWI, it became a day to mourn and honor its deceased servicemen and women. It is part of the US legal code (as I understand my source) that is now proclaimed as a day of prayer for permanent

peace. Last year's presidential proclamation contained the line, "This is always a day where pain and pride are mixed together." We will gather at our parish cemetery for Mass at 8:15 am, weather permitting, and later read the names of all those we know to be buried there who have served in the military. There will be a short American Legion service at 9:15 am. Please bring a lawn chair. If it is raining too much, we will have Mass at the Church. Our cemetery is at 9731 Airport Road, or just where Hartmann Road and Airport Road intersect south of Highway 5. I know many people will celebrate the day by traveling, going to a cabin to open it for the summer, having family over, having picnic dinners, or in other ways. Please do spend some time visiting a cemetery to visit someone who has died. It renews

the value of a place to gather to remember those who have died and a reminder of our own mortality. It is good to consider that now and then.

Our school year will end on Wednesday, as do many area schools. We conclude our school year with a Mass at 10:00 am. There will be no 8:15 am Mass that day. After Mass, which is attended by many parents and friends of the school, lunch is offered and then the children are dismissed for the summer.

I will again offer this deal to all students: read two books, and remember something from two homilies, and you are invited to an ice cream social following the 10:30 am Mass on Sunday, August 25. So Read, and come to Mass this summer! If you are traveling, explore what the Church is like where you are going. Take Flat Fr. Stan with you as well. He loves seeing churches! Flat Fr. Stan sheets are available in the narthex. Many people simply take a picture of it and display it on their cell phone at the church they attend on vacation.

By the time most of you read this, our 8th graders will have returned from their trip to Wisconsin. The itinerary included Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine in La Crosse, Wisconsin Dells, the House on the Rock, a zoo, Lambeau Field, and the National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion in the Green Bay area. There will be some learning experiences on the trip as well. This is a good group of students – I hope they will have had a fun time.

Did you know that four separate Eucharistic Processions are converging on Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress in July? One of them began at the headwaters of the Mississippi River earlier this month. Thousands of people attended a Mass and the first steps of that pilgrimage. It passes through our Archdiocese this week. The largest event will be on Memorial Day afternoon as the Blessed Sacrament will be processed from the Saint Paul Seminary along the Mississippi River to the Cathedral of St. Paul. It will begin with mid-day prayer at the seminary at 12:45 pm and then end at the Cathedral with prayer around 4:00 pm. The day will conclude with an ice cream social. Buses will return people to the starting place. One need not walk the entire 4.5-mile route. Check www.archspm.org for all the information. There are further processions or chances to gather for adoration at many parishes large and small throughout this whole week.





