


October is a pro-life month. Our Pro-Life group will be presenting a series of issues highlighted by posters in the narthex and some articles in the bulletin. These are issues for all ages: certainly, abortion is one issue, and another is end-of -life issues, such as euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide. It is also important to understand the laws in the state of Minnesota, and this information will be included in the material presented in the coming month.

You recall that Roe vs. Wade, the Supreme Court decision of 1973 which allowed abortion in many cases throughout the country, was overturned in the summer of 2022. The result of that decision (Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization) returned the power to regulate abortion to state and federal legislatures. This has made the focus of abortion, and often other life issues, focus on states even more so than at the federal level. In Minnesota, the party favoring more liberal abortion laws - indeed very liberal laws - had a slim margin in both houses of the state legislature. The Senate is currently split evenly with the one seat (in the Woodbury area) determining who will control the Senate. The house currently is split 68-64 between the DFL and Republicans respectively, with two vacancies. All 134 seats are up for election in 2024. Please inform yourselves of the positions of the various candidates in these and all important issues. Please take note of the displays you will see in October.

Pope Francis, who has often spoken more gently about some issues than some of his predecessors, has never gone soft on the issue of abortion. In January, he used the term "horrific" in his State of the World address. In 2021 he said, "Abortion is murder ... It's a human life, period." In 2023 he said, "Peace requires before all else the defense of life, a good that today is jeopardized ... through the promotion of an alleged 'right to abortion.' No one, however, can claim rights over the life of another human being, especially one who is powerless and thus completely defenseless. For this reason, I appeal to the consciences of men and women of goodwill, particularly those having political responsibilities, to strive to safeguard the rights of those who are weakest and to combat the throwaway culture." Most recently, on the papal plane, returning from his lengthy trip to Asia, Pope Francis, when to provide counsel to American Catholic votes in the upcoming election, noted first of all, since he is not American, he will not be voting, but also expressed his opinion that both major presidential candidates are against life and advised American Catholics to choose who they think is the "lesser evil" in the coming U.S. elections. No candidates were mentioned by name.

For the day I was two for four, on base three times (safe on an error once), and suffered an 8-pitch strikeout. I stole a base and scored a run. Final totals: 3 for 16, (.188 batting average); .294 on-

base percentage, 1 RBI, 2 runs, 1 stolen base, and a .482 OPS. Far less than last year, but I enjoyed my time.

A big thank you to our generous donors and dedicated volunteers for making this memorable night possible!






# LET'S TALK ABOUT PRO-LIFE




