There will be a special Christmas Bulletin, so I will save my heartiest Christmas greetings for that bulletin. If you will be traveling during these days, please do so safely, and we will see you later in the Christmas season. The Christmas Season this year ends on January 12.

On December 17, the daily Advent readings flipped to tell of events shortly before the nativity to help us prepare more directly for the Lord's birth. This provides for an octave before Christmas as well as an octave after it. In addition, at evening prayer, we introduce the canticle of Mary, the Magnificat, with the "O Antiphons" concluding the night of December 23 with Emmanuel, which you will recognize as the verses of O Come, O Come Emmanuel. These are very ancient. The hymn is from the 8th or 9th century, but they are referred to in liturgical books around the end of the 5th century. They are in order: Wisdom, Lord, Root of Jesse, Key of David, Rising Sun, King of the Nations, and God with Us. If the names (*in Latin*) are put in reverse order, it spells out "ero cras", which means "tomorrow I come."

You may be noticing two things about the pews this weekend: one, the spray bottles may have been removed. They served a significant role for some time, but many of us have moved on from that, much like we have been able to move on from the dispensers on the large white plywood stands we had in 2020-21. Some people still use them, so we will keep some bottles in the back of the church for you to take to your pew. Please return them there after Mass or begin relying on bringing your own in a pocket or purse. We have found recently that children are just using them as spray toys. The second thing you will notice is the areas in the pews with the missing varnish from spraying during COVID-19 have been refinished! Thanks to Dale Willenbring and any helpers he had in finding a product that did that quickly and inexpensively. It was all done by volunteers in a matter of a few hours and a few cans of spray.

We will be decorating for Christmas at 9:00 am on Monday, December 23. We would appreciate your help. We decorate not only the main church but also the narthex and chapel and in the parish center. Many people are there






